

- (339) I give and bequeath to my daughter Ann Pappan one negro Girl named
Sally, one feather bed and furniture, two Cows and Calves two Ewes and Lambs
which she has now in her possession all of which I give to my said daugh-
ter and to her heirs forever. I also give to my said daughter twenty five
pounds Cash to be raised out of my Estate after the death of my wife.
- 6th I give and bequeath to my daughter Sally Harris one negro Girl named
Daphney, one feather bed and furniture, two Cows and Calves and two
Ewes and Lambs to her and her heirs forever. I also give to my said daugh-
ter twenty five pounds Cash to be raised out of my Estate after the death of my
wife.
- 7th I give and bequeath to my daughter Lucy Harris one negro Girl
named Mary, one feather bed and furniture, two Cows and Calves
two Ewes and Lambs and two negro Girls pound Cash to be raised out of
my Estate after the death of my wife to her and her heirs forever.
- 8th I give and bequeath to my son John Harris one negro Boy called Tom,
one feather bed and furniture, one Horse and one Slew and pig to him and
his heirs forever. I also give to my said after the death of my said wife the
land and plantation that I have given for the use of during her
natural life to him my said son and to his heirs forever. Reserving to
my daughter Lucy the right of living in the dwelling house with
my said son so long as he may remain unmarried. - My will
and desire is that after the death of my wife there be as much of my personal
estate disposed of as will be sufficient to enable my ones hereafter named
have my daughters above named the several Legacies given them in cash
and the remainder of my my estate of every kind and Quality what-
ever given my said wife the use of; be equally divided amongst all my
Children as they may think best namely Mary Brantley Ann
Pappan Sally Harris Sam Harris John Harris, and Lucy Harris to them
to their heirs forever, but in case of the death of either of above named children
and Grand Children without lawful Issue in that case my will
and desire my will and desire is that the part that I have given to
them should be equally divided betwixt the surviving ones; I constitute and
appoint my two sons Sam and John Harris my whole and sole
executors of my will and desire. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and
