I, John William do make and declare this my last will and
 testament in manner and form following (to wit)
 I leave to my wife Mary During her life the use of one hundred
 acres of Land and the houses wherein I now live together with my
 lay man Mary, Also one bed and furniture one Cow &
 Pigs, one Can and Culp. two head sheep, twenty barrels Corn five
 hundred pounds Pork or Bacon equal thereto, half Dozen
 plates two dishes and two pots - After her Death I give & bequeath
 to my grand son Anthony William the land above described
 that I lent to my wife, also my Desk and books and one Dresser
 bed, The balance of my Land I desire to be equally Divided in
 two parts, one half I give and bequeath to my Daughter Sally
 Gardner to her and her heirs forever - The other half I give
 and bequeath to my daughter Mary Clark to her and her heirs
 forever - I give and bequeath to my daughter Annemore Byrnes being
 five pounds to be paid out of my estate hereafter to be mentioned
 I give and bequeath to my Grand Daughter Alsie Maglison one
 bed and furniture and one Cow - I give to John William son
 of my sister Mary Williams twenty Dollars also my wearing
 Apparel - I give to Sally Clark daughter of John Clark
 five Dollars - It is my desire that all the remainder of
 my property be sold to pay my Debts and Legacies and
 the remainder of the money arising therefrom and Debts
 due me, to be collected, be divided between my Grand Children
 I do Appoint my friends Asa Gardner Thomas Chappell and
 Benjamin Baxam, Executors of this my Last will and testament
 In witness whereof I have set my hand and Seal at this 18th day
 December 1804
