I Ephraim Draper of the County of Suffolk
and State of Mass. being of sound mind and memory as I think proper to make
and ordain this as my last Will and Testament in manner following to wit
I Give to my Loving wife Elizabeth Draper one half of my house
during her natural life or widow hood - I Give and bequeath
to my son Thomas Draper one half of my house & plantations
lately to take immediate possession of and the other half at the
half of the marriage or death of my Loving wife Elizabeth
Draper all my black Smiths tools of every kind whatever one
Silver Watch and one Work Steer to him and his heirs forever
I Give and bequeath to my Daughter Elizabeth Draper
one feather bed and furniture one wooden wheel one pair
Cotton Cords one pine chest with drawers one horse to her and
her heirs forever - I Give and bequeath to my Daughter
Peggy Draper one feather bed and furniture one wooden
wheel one pair Cotton Cords one pine chest one flat rim plow wheel
and to her heirs forever - I Give and bequeath to my Loving
wife Elizabeth Draper after paying all my Just Debts all
the remainder of my estate of what nature or kind soever that
is not herein otherwise Given Away and bequeathed forever
Lastly I constitute and appoint my Loving Elizabeth Draper
and Joseph Denson my whole and sole Executors and assigns
to this my last Will and Testament discharging and making
all other wills heretofore made - Witness my hand and seal the
26th day of September 1804
