of the County of Southampton Parish being now and in good health and
thanks to god in perfect sense and memory, do make this my last
will and Testament in manner and form following, first I bequeath my soul
to god who gave it hoping through the merits of blessed redemption
Christ, to receive full pardon for my sins, my body to be Decently buried and
as for my worldly estate I give and bequeath as follows: I leave I give
all my property I now possess to my son *Victor Edlin* three feather beds &
furniture and toys and two pots two wheels one Chute and one loom
and six or seven and *Bartholomew* ward, one span and *Skillet* and six
hair and stock of beer two Cows two mounds one Looking glass and
also my clothes and two Axes two hoes two Iron shovels and one
my gun and one musket of safety and lastly I nominate and appoint
my son *Victor Edlin* my executor of this my last will and Testament making
void all other bequests made by me made in Confirmation whereof I have
herunto set my hand and seal this 20th day of April 1804
