blanket three dollars in cash and one set of cups and saucers

I give and bequeath to my Daughter Martha Davis one Bed and furniture and
one blue flowered Blanket and three Dollars in Cash and one half dozen
Eggs plates and one patcher.

Now I appoint William Kitcher my executor I Deliver this as my hand
