Item I give and bequeath unto my son Edmund Wood my fore negroes viz moses Judy Idas an parthena and their increase one mare and colt one cart and wheel and all my Croonware & to Kittle to him and his heirs forever.

Item I give and bequeath to my three grandsons Nicholas Jones Joshua Jones and Levy Jones one bed and furniture also forty Dollars apiece for year for three board whilst they keep them beginning in march one thousand Eight Hundred and three to be paid by Nathaniel Jones to my Executors and by them to the said Children and their heirs forever.

Item I give and bequeath unto my four grand sons John Wood Joshua Wood William Wood and Joshua Wood my sorrel horse to them and their heirs forever Then all the rest of my Estate to be sold and equally divided between my son Edmund Wood the one part Daughters Marys Child and the other part to them and their heirs forever There by constitute and appoint my son Edmund Wood and Samuel Pond my sole Executors to my last will and testament in witness whereof I have set my hand and seal the eighth tenth day of June in the year one thousand Eight hundred and five Signed sealed in presence of
