Itemth I lend to my well beloved wife Mary Willons. The use of my plantation wherein I now live containing One Hundred & Seventy five Acres (more or less) during her natural life, & after her decease I give the S^d. one Hundred & Seventy five acres (more or less) to my daughter, Anna Willons. to her & to her heirs & assigns forever. I also lend all the remainder of my Estate (as I have not given away before) to my well beloved wife Mary To raise, Board, & School my young Children until my youngest child arrives to the age of Eighteen years it is my desire that my wife should keep the Beds, that I have given away, until my children arrives to the age of Twenty One years; if a division do not take place before my youngest child arrives to the age of Eighteen years - I then give all the residue, & remainder of my Estate of what kind or nature soever, to be equally divided between my wife, & each of my Children as I now shall name, William B. Willons. Peggy Willons Hartwell & Polly Willons - if my wife should die before my youngest child is eighteen years of age & the children not School'd, I want some provision to be made by my Executors out of my estate towards Boarding & Schooling of them before a final Division takes place.

Itemth I give my title to my two Sons William B. & Miles Willons to be equally divided to them & to their heirs & assigns forever.

Itemth My will & desire is that all the all the profits that may arise out of my Estate, (if any) may be carefully kept together & then be equally divided with my Estate.

Itemth I appoint my well beloved wife Mary Willons John H. Pond & William B. Willons. my Executors to this my last Will & Testament given and in my hand & Seal this day of June 1806
