which I bought of John W. Kea just. also I give unto
my daughter Charlotte Eliza Taylor the debt due from
Benja^a Drew & W^m Boykin she paying out of this debt
for the above mentioned Land bought of John M^r Kea

I will also give unto my aforename daughter Charlotte Eliza
Taylor Shares in the Virginia Bank & one Half of my funded
Certificates or stock due from the M^t States:

Fifthly I give unto my aforementioned Daughter Sarah Williamson Taylor one half of my funded certificates, or stock Due from the Ntates. also thirty two Shares in the Virginia bank, one half the debt due from John T. Blow & Jas. Brecklow the other half to my daughter Charlotte Eliza Taylor

Sixthly. I gave all the other debts due me to be divided between my Son Bennett Taylor & my two Daughters Sarah W^mson & Charlotte Eliza -
