disposing Mind and Memory. Thanks to God for the same do make
and Ordain the following to be my last Will and Testament in
manner and form following Vizt.

Item: I will that my just Debts and Funeral Expences be punctually paid
and discharged by my Ex^{rs}. hereafter Named

Item: I give and bequeath unto my wife Mary Turner the use of my
Plantation with the use of every other article of my property of
Whatsoever kind it may consist in during her natural Life

Item: I give and bequeath unto my son Samuel Turner one horse Coat
unto him and his heirs forever

Item: I give and bequeath unto my Son Zachariah Turner at the
Death of my Loving wife Mary Turner all my Land of every part
Containing one hundred & fifteen and a half Acres more or
less with one Sorrel Horse unto him and his heirs forever

Item: The Remainder parts of my estate of Whatsoever kind it may consist in
to be equally divided between my five Children Vizt Samuel Polly
Patsy Woodard, Joseph Johnson and Nancy to be possessed by them
and their heirs forever

Item: I do hereby commit my youngest Son to the charge of my
Brother Samuel Turner to be tutored by him as may be seen
with him

Lastly I do hereby appoint my loving wife with my son

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
