In the name of God amen I John Thorp of the County of Southampton being sick & weak of body but of sound and disposing mind and memory thanks be given to almighty God for the same do make and constitute this my last will and Testament in form and manner following -

My will is that there should be a line run across my Land beginning at a white Oak near the place called the rider crossway in Wm Gwatneys line to a black Gum in Peuben Whitfields line in the deep branch and all the Land lying to the East of that line I give to my son Joseph and if he should die without a lawful heir begotten of his body I give the same to my son Edmund and his heirs forever -

Item I give all the remaining part of my Land to be equally divided between my two sons Edmund and Joshua and if either should die without heir lawfully begotten of his body my will and desire is that the Survivor should hold the whole teniment hereby intended to be divided between them to him and his heirs forever -

Item I give all my personal estate of every kind to my loving wife Charity during her life or widowhood and after her decease to be equally divided between all my children Lastly I do appoint my son Joseph Thorp Executor of this my last will and Testament. In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this 15 Day of August 1803
