

Forty shillings, to Pamela Bailey the sum of five pounds, to, Anna Bailey the sum of Ten pounds, to Jesse Bailey the sum of Ten pounds, to, Mary Cathop Bailey the sum of Ten pounds, and the remainder equally divided between all my daughters that may be then living, but should either of my daughters die and leave issue to my will that such issue shall take the proportion of the sale of said plantation that the mother would have been intitled to, had she lived— It is also my will that after the death of my said wife the three Negroes above named Bep. mial and Jack, with all the other articles given her during her life should be sold and the money arising the said sale to be equally divided between all my children that may be then living—

Item. I Give and bequeath to my Son Benjamin Carrell the Tract of Land purchased of Edwin Gray containing two hundred and ninety five acres be the same more or less. I likewise give my said Son one Negro boy named Sam, with property I have already given him in possession to him and his heirs and assigns forever—

Item. I Give and bequeath to my daughter Mary Brittle one Negro Girl named Anio and all the property I have already given her in possession to her, her heirs and assigns forever—

Item. I Give and bequeath to my daughter Jane Brittle one negro girl named Phillis and all the property I have already given her in possession to her her heirs and assigns forever—

Item. I Give and bequeath to my daughter Sarah Carrell one Negro boy named Philip (also) Mansfield, one feather bed and furniture, three pounds cash, one spinning wheel one chest one pewter dish, one half gallon barrel six pewter plates, and one of flat Irons. to her her heirs and assigns forever—

Item. I Give and bequeath to my daughter Rebecca Carrell one negro girl named Mully one feather bed and furniture three pounds Cash one spinning wheel one chest one pewter dish, one half gallon barrel six pewter plates and one of flat Irons to her her heirs assigns forever—

My will and desire is that all the remainder of my estate should be sold and equally divided among all my children that may be living. It is also my will that my estate shall not be appraised—

And Lastly I do hereby constitute and appoint my Son Benjamin Carrell whol and sole executor of this my last will and Testament hereby revoking all other wills by me heretofore made.
