and Town of Jerusalem being now Sick but of Sound mind and memory do
ordain this to be my last Will and Testament to wit
I give and bequeath to my beloved wife Foreby Vich, my Lot and House
whereon I now live No 12 during her widowhood or natural life and in
Case she marries or dies then the said Lot and House No 12 to be equally
divided between my Two Daughters Nancy Vich or in other words Nancy
Doyal, and Martha Vich to them and their Heirs forever but if they
Should both die without Heirs then it is my will that Labourn
Vich Son of Simmons Vich Should have the S. Lot and House forever
I do also wish all my house hold & Kitchen Furniture be sold and the
money arising therefrom to pay all my just Debts and the balance if
any to be divided between my said wife & Two daughters Nancy &
Martha

And lastly I do appoint my friend Josiah Vich my sole & sole Executor

according to law for administration with the will annexed on P.
