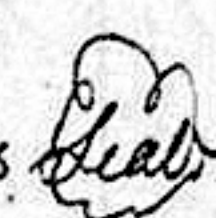


And at my wifes death I desire that the negroes belonging to her estate then should be equally divided between all my Children & the balance of my Cattle not given to my wife I desire to be sold & the money equally divided between all my Children - I give unto my daughter - Jimmy Williams my negroe girl Jills to her and her heirs forever, but if she dies without heir to be divided between the rest of my Children - I give to Daughter Meriah one negroe girl Liza to her and her heirs forever, but if she dies without heir then to be equally divided between my Children - I give to my wife two be hives and the rest to be sold and the money applied as before mentioned - Lastly I leave my beloved wife Polly Williams my Executrix and my friend William E. Price my executor of this my last will with Testament - In witness I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this 16th day of May 1806

Williams and Thomas D.
