Item I give unto William Saunders one Hundred and fifteen acres of Land his the same more or less that I bought of Brittain Barnes to him and his heirs forever

Item I give unto my nephew David Myrick his Bonds and Interests due them to me for Three Hundred and Ninety Dollars to him and his heirs forever

Item I give unto my nephew Henry E. Williamson his Bonds and Interests due me for ninety Dollars to him and his heirs forever

Item I give two Hundred Dollars as a token of esteem to be equally divided between my Negroes hereafter named (to wit) Susan Fegan Cook Ben Nute Jim Charles Stephen Nix and Bob

Item I give all the remaining part of my estate of all kinds whatsoever not already given away with all my old corn and crop of every kind now on the ground unto my loving wife Betsey Edmunds to her and her heirs forever — and lastly I do hereby constitute and appoint my Nephews Ethelred Edmunds and David Myrick and John Nicholson whole and sole Executors of this my last will and Testament the day and year first above written
