County being weak of Body but of sound mind and memory do make
and ordain this my last will and Testament in the following manner -

Item

I lend to my loved wife Hannah Harrison the use of half my land
and Plantation whereon I now live also three negroes namely Rachel
Venus & Sophia one feather bed and furniture one horse two Cows &
Calves of her choice during her natural life, also I give to my said wife
Twenty Barrels Corn and two Sows and pigs, and at the death of my wife
all the property lent her except the Land and two negroes (to wit)
Rachel and Venus shall be equally divided between my children
Temperance Harrison, Henry Harrison and Benjamin Harrison.

Item

I give to my Daughter Temperance Harrison one negro woman
named Aggy and her Child Sarah two feather beds and furniture two Cows
& Calves one bag mare called polly and two Ewes to her and her heirs forever

Item

I give to my son Henry Harrison one half of my land the part he
now lives on to him and his heirs forever also one negro woman named
Susan with her present and future increase two feather beds and
furniture two Cows and Calves one yearling two Horses the Horses and
yearling he hath in possession at this time, two Ewes and lambs and six
Hundred and fifty Dollars to him and his heirs forever
