I give to my son Benjamin Harrison after the death of my beloved Wife the other half of my land and plantation wheron I now live to him and his heirs forever also four negroes namely Dolly Chang Nathan and Carter and at the death of my wife two negroes named Rachel and Venus and their future increase two feather Beds and furniture one Sorrel mare called Fanny one bay Horse called Roland two Cows and Calves two Ewes and Lambs and two Hundred Dollars to him and his heirs forever

Item

I Give to my Grandson Harrison M. Cumore one grey mare one feather Bed and furniture one Cow and yearling two Sows and two Sheep the feather Bed he hath in possession to him and his heirs forever also two Hundred dollars to be deposited in the hands of my son Henry Harrison to be paid out for the support of said Harrison M. Cumore as my son Henry shall think proper

Item

I give to my grandson Paschal Blow Harrison provided he arrives to the age of twenty one year two hundred Dollars to him and his heirs forever if not to be equally divided between my three Children Temperance Henry and Benjamin to them and their heirs forever

Item

My will and desire is that my negro woman Ginny should be equally divided between my two sons Henry and Benjamin Harrison to them and their heirs forever

Item

My will and desire is that the residue of my Estate be equally divided between my three Children Temperance Harrison Henry Harrison and Benjamin Harrison to them and their heirs forever

Item

If my daughter Temperance Harrison should die without lawful issue born under wedlock then and in that case I give all the Estate of every kind which I have given her to my two sons Henry and Benjamin Harrison to be equally divided between them to them and their heirs forever

Item

If either of my sons should die without lawful issue then and in that case I give all the Estate of every kind I have given him to the surviving Brother and his heirs forever

I do constitute and appoint my two sons Henry Harrison and Benjamin Harrison the whole and sole Executors of this my last will and Testament. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this 30th day of July Eighteen hundred and seven
