Whereas I Christian Vick of Southampton County in Virginia being sick
and weak of body but of sound mind and disposing memory do make
Re and ordain this my last will and testament in manner and form
that is to say my just debts and funeral expenses first paid I give
devise and bequeath as follows - - - - -

Imprimis

It is my will and desire that the lands conveyed to me by a deed of gift
from Jacob Vick bearing date the 27th day of February 1801 may fall
into Equal distribution among the Surviving heirs of Jesse Vick Deceased
in the same manner with this on which I now reside to them and their
heirs forever - - - - -

Imprimis

I give devise and Bequeath unto my brother John Knox one hundred
Dollars to him and his heirs forever - - - - -

Item

I give devise and bequeath unto Mourning Jordan one hundred dollars
to her and her heirs forever - - - - -

Item

I give and devise all my Wearing apparel to Mary Copeland to her and
her heirs forever - - - - -

Imprimis

I give devise and bequeath all the remainder of my Estate not above
disposed of to be equally divided between Lemuel Vick, Richard
Jordan of Benjamin, Patience Vick, Christian Jordan, Elizabeth Vick
of Williams and Nancy Knox to them their heirs and assigns forever
Lastly I nominate constitute and appoint Benjamin Jordan and
Williams Vick my Executors to this my last will Revoking disallowing
and making void all other and former wills by me heretofore made
This I do to be my last will and Testament in witness Whereof I have
set to my hand and seal this 8th day of Dec^r 1805
