County being in a low state of health at present in body but in my
usual senses do make this my last Will and Testament in manner
and form as followeth (to wit) —

I give and bequeath unto my son Charles Bradshaw the land and
plantation whereon I now now live containing 150 acres more or less to
him and his heirs forever and should he die without such heir to go to
daughter Lucy Bradshaw and to her heirs forever —

I give unto my daughter Lucy Bradshaw one negro boy named him
one feather bed and furniture one chest to her and her heirs forever and
my will and desire is that my plantation where John Winaam now
lives be Equally between my two Daughters Lucy and Melinda Bradshaw
my Will and desire is that at my death that my negro woman
Sarah shall have her freedom and have the liberty of her house where
she now lives during her life (Wiz) If the law will allow her to be
free if not I give her to my within named Daughter Lucy to her and
her heirs forever —
