Item I Give unto my beloved wife Priscilla English my negro boy (Tom) during her natural life

Item I Give unto my Daughter Sally English the Land and plantation Called popes place Containing one hundred and forty four Acres more or less to her and her heirs forever - also I Give unto my said Daughter Sally English one Bed and furniture - also Three head Cattle and two Sheep to her and her heirs forever

Item I Give unto my Daughter Elizabeth English the Land and plantation whereon I now live Containing one hundred and thirty five Acres be the same more or less - also I Give unto my said Daughter Elizabeth one bed and furniture - also Three head Cattle and two Sheep to her and her heirs forever
