In the Name of God Amen the 29th day of April in the year of our Lord
one thousand Eight hundred and seven. I Lewis Bryant Junr. of the County of
Southampton being weak in body but of sound mind and memory. Calling
to mind the Mortality of Body and knowing that it is appointed for all
men to die. I make and ordain this my last Will and Testament and
first of all I Recommend my soul to the hands of God that gave me it
and for my body I Recommend it to the earth to be buried in a decent
manner at the hands of my Executors and as keeping such worldly estate
as it hath pleased god to bless me with I give and dispose as followeth in
the manner and form -

I give to my son Jesse Bryant the land and plantation I now live on
Containing one hundred and twenty acres more or less to him and heirs
one mare and Colt one feather bed and furniture -

I give to my son Nicholas Bryant one bay horse by the name of Jack one
feather bed and furniture it being the first Choice one pair of Spoon moles
one gun first Choice to him and to his heirs forever -

I give to my son Matthew Bryant one Dollar to him and his heirs forever -

I give to my Daughter Elizabeth Browne one Dollar to her and her heirs forever -

I give to my Daughter Patsy Channel one Dollar to her and her heirs forever -

I give to my Daughter Alice Prailigh one Dollar to her and her heirs forever -
