 I give to my son Ethelred, one Negro boy named Tony - two Cows and calves two
 ewes and Lambs, and one feather bed and furniture to him and his heirs and assign
 s forever - - - - -
 I give to my Daughter Martha Warren, one Negro girl named Hannah, and
 increase, two Cows and Calves - two ewes and Lambs, and one feather bed and furni
 ture to her her heirs and assigns forever - - - - -
 I give to my Daughter Peggy one Negro girl named Treacy and increase, two Cows
 and Calves two ewes and Lambs and one feather bed and furniture to her her heirs and
 assigns forever - - - - -
 I give to my Daughter Priscilla Warren one negro girl, Rose and increase, two
 Cows and Calves - two Ewes and Lambs, and one feather bed and furniture - to her
 her heirs and assigns forever - - - - -
 I give to my son Samuel, (to be delivered to him or his proper representatives for
 his use and benefit immediately after the death or marriage of my wife, one
 negro man Pompey (herein before left to the use of my wife as mentioned in the first
 Item,) two Cows and calves - two ewes and Lambs and one bed and furniture to him
 his heirs and assigns forever - I also give to him to be delivered as above at the death
 of my wife all that part of my lands which lie in the state of Virginia - to him
 his heirs and assigns forever - - - - -
 I give to my son Robert Warren - one negro boy named Moses - two Cows and
 Calves - two Ewes and Lambs and one feather bed and furniture - I also give to my said
 son Robert, (to be delivered over to his use and benefit, immediately after the
 death or marriage of my wife all my lands being in the state of North Carolina
 the fishery excepted to him his heirs and assigns forever - - - - -
 Immediately after the death or marriage of my wife I give to my son Ethelred
 my fishing thereto - I also give him one hundred pounds cash, to be raised out of my
 part of my estate not herein before devised - which I give to him and his heirs
 and assigns forever - - - - -
