Elizabeth, Ethelreda - Robert - Martha - Peggy - Priscilla - and Samuel Warren which I give to them their heirs assigns forever -

Stem With respect to the land herein before given to my son Samuel Warren, it is to be understood and is hereby declared - that if my said son Samuel should die before he arrives to the age of twenty one years or has a lawful heir that in that case my will & desire is that the said land shall go & descend to my son Ethelreda Warren to him and his heirs forever - and it is further to be understood that the still now on the land should go with the land on which it stands -

Lastly

I hereby nominate appoint and constitute my wife Peggy R. Warren executrix and find Jacob Darden and my son Robert Warren - executors to this my last will and Testament. hereby declaring ratifying and confirming this and no other to be my last will and Testament - In Witness whereof I have hitherto set my hands and affixed my seal this thirteenth day of Decr. 1806
