 Item I give unto my Nephew James Ridley Son of William Ridley the Sum of Two Hundred
 pounds Current Money of Virginia to be raised out of my Money bonds and Tobacco
 sold to John and William Betts by William Maffenburg and the Interest that may
 accrue on the said Two Hundred pounds from this time
 Item I give unto my Niece Rebecca Maffenburg my mourning piece also my locket and my
 black Sattin cloak and one Silver punch Ladle and Two beds and furniture
 Item I give unto my Niece Elizabeth Blunt my Calico bed curtains and the bed and
 furniture to which they belong
 Item I give the residue of my Negroes not already disposed of to be equally divided
 amongst the living Children of my two Nieces Rebecca Maffenburg and Elizab
 the Blunt reserving the proportion that may be allotted unto Robert Maffenburg
 Children to her use during her natural life and also the proportion that may
 be allotted unto Elizabeth Blunt's Children to her use during her natural life
 and then to their Children and their Heirs forever
 Item I give the balance of the Bonds and money Money I have on hand after paying the
 Legacies left to my three Nephews in Carolina with my Stock of all kinds and
 my Household furniture not already disposed of to be equally divided between
 my two Nieces Rebecca Maffenburg and Elizabeth Blunt
 Item I give unto my Niece Rebecca Maffenburg the residue of my Estate including
 the profits of any should be made
 Item I Nominate and appoint my Nephew James Ridley Son Samuel Blunt
 and William Maffenburg Executors to this my last Will and Testament
 revoking all others heretofore made In Witness whereof I have hereunto set
 my hand and seal the Day and year above written

At a Court held for the County of Southampton on the 17th day of August
 1801. This will was presented in Court by Samuel Blunt and William Maffenburg
 with two of the execs therein named (and continued for James Ridley the other 2)
 proved by the oaths of Benjamin Dill and Elizabeth Dill the witnesses
 ordered to be recorded - And on the motion of the said execs who made
 Law Directs probat is granted him in and form giving security where
