the till and all the appurtenances thereto belonging. Also
four Negroes namely Anahy and her Increase, Barnard, Gilbert
and Hannah one mare called the whistwind, his choir of three head of
cattle two Sows and pigs, one Desk, the best Table one bed and furniture
and 4 doz. Walnut Chairs to him and his heirs forever -

Item I Give and bequeath unto my Daughter Patsy M. Pastours Four
Negroes namely Abby, Riach, Macklen and Cherry one feather bed
and furniture and Fifty pounds Cash also three head of cattle
to her and her heirs forever -

Item I Give and bequeath unto my Daughter Nancy Boykin Five
negroes namely Adam, Hussy, Claibourne, Cay and Fortimores one
Bed and Furniture and three cattle 2^d choice also the sum of
Fifty pounds Cash to her and her heirs forever -

The remainder of my estate not heretofore mentioned, (after my just
Debts are paid) I wish to be sold and equally divided between Mary
A. Whitehead Patsy M. Pastours, and Nancy Boykin (my three
Daughters) to them and their heirs forever -

I appoint my loving son Samuel Boykin my whole and sole
Executor of this my last will and Testament, In witness whereof
