And lastly I give and devise to John Urquhart after the aforesaid legacies paid and delivered all my Estate of every kind whosoever as well real as personal to him and his heirs forever, except my negro man Charles which I desire may be emancipated - And hereby appoint the said John Urquhart & Joshua Fort my Executors - ratifying this and no other to be my last Will. Mary Williams Will
In the name of God Amen the thirtieth day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety six - I Mary Williams of the County of Southampton being weak in body but of sound memory; do make and ordain this my last Will and Testament in the manner and form following Viz -

I give and Bequeath unto my nephew Lewis Warrell, the Cott my mare are now folden with to him and his heirs forever, also one Hand Mill to him and His heirs forever - And my will and desire is that at my death if I have over eight Hogs I give unto my nephew Josiah Warrell four; if under eight to be equally divided between my two nephews Lewis and Josiah Warrell. to them and their heirs forever; also my will and desire is; if I have four head Cattle at my death, I give unto my nephew Josiah two; if under four; to be equally divided between my two nephews Lewis and Josiah Warrell to them and their heirs forever -
