In the name of god Amen, I James Drew of the County of Southampton do make and ordain this my last Will and testament revoking and Disannulling all other wills heretofore by me made in manner and form following (to wit)
I lend to my beloved wife Minnifred all my lands, during Widowhood. or untill my son Jesse Drew arrives to the age of twenty one years, then it is my wish and desire that if my wife should die my that all my land except one third of the same should be sold and the money arising from the sale to be equally divided between my Children. - also my wish and desire is if my wife should die before my son Jesse arrives to the age of twenty one years, that all my land should be sold and the money divided as before directed - - - - -

I Give to my beloved wife when she marries or my son Jesse arrives to age of twenty one years, One fifth part of all my personal estate my will and desire is that the residue of my estate of what kind sever should be equally divided between all my Children & lastly I do nominate and appoint my beloved Wife, and my Uncle Frederick Parker my whole and sole Executors of this my last will and testament, In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & affixed my Seal this first day of November, Eighteen hundred & seven
