

478 In the name of God Amen. I, E. Harris of Southampton County
being of sound mind and memory do make and ordain this my last
to be my last will and testament in manner and form following

1st I give and bequeath to my brother John Harris the land & plantation
whereon I now live with the following Slaves, Lizzie Davey, Ann Davey
and Dick (with their increase) also all the Stock of Horses, (excepting
all the Stock of Cattle, Hogs and Sheep to him & his heirs forever

2nd I give and bequeath to my sister Nancy Harwell five hundred dollars,
to her and her heirs forever, also one Still of forty Gallons now on the
plantation whereon I now live, to her & her heirs forever

3rd I give and bequeath to my sister Avey Prepsaw six hundred dollars
one feather Bed, and furniture to her and her heirs forever

4th I give and bequeath to my sister Sarah Harris six hundred dollars
one Horse, (her choice of my Stock,) One bed and furniture, one
Copper Kettle to her and her heirs forever

5th I give and bequeath to my sister Lucy Harris six hundred Dollars
One bed and furniture, to her and her heirs forever

6th I give and bequeath to my Niece Elizabeth Brantley One hundred
dollars, and if she dies before she arrives to the age of twenty one
years, or marries, in that case, I give it to her mother Mow Nancy
Harwell to her and her heirs forever

7th My Will and desire is that all the residue and remainder of my
Estate of every kind Soever that is not already given away I do
give and bequeath it to my Brother John Harris to him and his
heirs forever. I constitute and appoint my Brother John
Harris the whole and sole executor of this my last will and testam-
ent, utterly revoking and annulling all other wills by me made
