cept my tools And one half of the fruit that is raised off of my
orchard for ten years & one bee hive to him forever —

Item I give and bequeath unto my son James Council all the remain-
der of my plantation with his mother's single life in it as before
stated, and one long gun one inch half inch and three quarter
augers two bee hives one hatchet and one broad axe and one drawing
knife to him and his heirs forever —

Item My will and desire is that the still that is now planted on my son
James Council's part of the land shall be sold to pay my just
debts — — — — —

Item I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Dice Doyal one feather bed &
furniture one colt that she has in possession, one cow yearling and
one bee hive to her and her heirs forever — — — — —

Item My will and desire is that all the remainder of my estate except
the legacies here mentioned to be sold to pay my just debts and if
any remainder equally divide between my wife and three children
Edwin Disa and James — — — — —

Item I do appoint Benja^a Griffin and my son Edwin Council my whole &
Executors to this my last will and testament. In witness I do here-
unto set my hand and seal this 10th day of November 1807 —
