In the name of God Amen — I William Beal of Southampton county and State of Virginia being of Sound mind and memory, but calling to mind the uncertainty of this life, do make Constitute & ordain this to be my last will and Testament — First I recommend my soul to my blessed redeemer, and my body to the dust until the general resurrection; and all my worldly Estate I dispose of in manner and form following —

First I desire, all my just debts to be paid; and the residue of my estate I give and bequeath as follows —

Item. I Give and bequeath unto my son Jordan Beal, his heirs and assigns forever, by giving his brothers and sisters sixty dollars, the whole of two tracts of Land I purchased of Henry Briggs and Edmund Johnson, containing by estimation three hundred and forty acres; be the same more or less also I give my son Jordan one feather bed and furniture, and one cow and calf —

Item I Give and bequeath unto my son Samuel Beal, his heirs and assigns forever, the plantation, and lands whereon I now live with same exception; which I shall hereafter make also I give unto my son Samuel, one feather bed and furniture & one cow and calf —
