I give and bequeath unto my son George Masan the following Negroes Namely, Roger sen^r Milly sen^r Charles, David, Buck, Dammore, Roger j^r & Milly j^r together with their future increase, to him and his heirs forever, but it is my particular request and desire to my said son George Masan, that after he gets possession of my two old Negroes Roger sen^r and Milly sen^r that he let them remain on the place they now live on, that they may do for themselves, and that have a good house and that my said son George Masan should cloath and furnish them good sufficient support during their lives. After the Death of my said husband Robert Mabry, I lend unto my daughter James Masan during her life, the following Negroes (Viz) Tom, Hill bealy, Washington, Caesar and Lunc and their future increase, and at her death, for the said Negroes to be equally divided between all the children my said daughter Jane Masan may leave; to them and their heirs —

I give and bequeath unto my grand daughter Rebecca Thweatt Masan the following Negroes (Viz) Charlotte and Alfred after the death of my said husband Robert Mabry; to her and her heirs —

After the death of my said husband Robert Mabry I desire that all the rest and residue of my estate heretofore in this will not given away, may be equally divided between my two children George Masan and Jane Masan —

My will and desire is that my estate should not be Inventoried, nor appraised, nor that my executors hereafter named should not give security for their executorship
