between my three children Namely James Johnson, Olive Johnson
and Cytha Johnson to them and their heirs forever

And lastly, I do appoint my friend John Crumpler to be my whole
and sole Executor of this my last will and Testament disannulling
and making void all other wills by me heretofore made. In Witness
