I Winnifred Ivey of Southampton County and parish of Saint Luke being in my perfect senses do make this my last will and testament

I give to my Brother Ephraim Ivey of Georgia twenty five pounds which is half the money he owes me; and the other half which is twenty Five pounds - I give to my two Brothers Peoples Ivey and Sampson Ivey to be equally divided to them and their heirs -

I give to Elizabeth Ivey widow of Aram Ivey Decd. the sum of ten pounds cash to her and her heirs -

I give to my Sister Christian Ivey the sum of Ten pounds cash to her and her heirs -

I give to Elizabeth Grizzard, wife of John Grizzard the sum of five pounds cash to her and her heirs -

I give to Mrs. Phoeby Harris the sum of three pounds cash to her and her heirs -

I give to Lurany Ivey three pounds cash to her and her heirs

My will and desire is that none of my Wareing appall be sold but to be equally divided between Christian Ivey Betty Ivey, widow of Aram Ivey, Decd. and Liddie Ivey wife of Peoples Ivey - The balance of my property I desire may be sold of whatsoever kind it may be or wheresoever found except ten yards of cloth - I give to the wife of John Grizzard and she is to have her choice -

and the money arising from such sale - I give to Equally divided between Ephraim Ivey, Peoples Ivey, Sampson Ivey, Christian Ivey and Elizabeth Ivey widow of Aram Ivey Decd. -

My Will and desire is that my estate not to be appraised -

Lastly I nominate and appoint John Reese and Zebulon Lewis my executors to this my last will. revoking and making null and void all other wills heretofore made by me. the 30th day of March 1808
