I give to my well beloved Sister Sally Britt one Negro girl named
Charlotte to her and her heirs forever —

I give to my nephew Samuel Britt one Negro Boy named Jordan
if in case my nephew Samuel Britt should die without
lawful heir, I give the said Boy Jordan to my Niece Lizzy
Britt to her and her heirs forever —

I give to my Niece Lizzy Britt one Negro girl named Lavinia
if in case my Nephew Lizzy Britt should die without lawful
heir I give the said girl Lavinia to my nephew Samuel Britt to
him and his heirs forever. also I give one feather bedstead and
furniture to my Niece Lizzy Britt in like manner & form

I give to my brother in law Joseph Britt one Negro woman na-
med Blas and one Negro girl named Partha to him and his
heirs forever —

My will and desire is that my Brother in law Joseph Britt sho-
uld act as my whole and sole executor to this my last will and
Testament —
