 Estate real and personal shall continue as it now is until
 my Eldest Son James Williamson Parker arrive at the
 age of twenty one, then my Will and desire is that there
 shall an equal division take place between my loving wife
 Temperance Parker, James Williamson Parker Solomon Deloach
 Parker and Joseph Henry Parker of D. Estate But in case
 of my wifes Death or Marriage then my Will and desire is
 that my D. Estate be divided as the Law directs, my further desire
 is that my Children be liberally educated out of my estate
 without touching any part or partake of their estate indivi-
 dually my further desire is that in case the Lands now
 belonging to Dolly Finch the wife of William Finch shall
 be sold sold, that my Executors whom I hereafter nominate
