I give and bequeath unto my beloved Son Henry Taylor one negro
Boy Joshua and Sarah mare one cow and calf all the crop
of Corn fodder and Brandy made on the plantation to him
and his heirs forever
I give and bequeath unto my beloved Daughter Nancy Fitzhugh
my riding Chair also I lend unto Said Daughter Nancy Fitzhugh
one negro woman Aina and her increase during her life and
after her death to be equally divided between her children &c
I give and bequeath unto my beloved Daughter Eliza Petersen
one negro girl Mary and her increase one cow and calf to
her and to her heirs forever
I give and bequeath unto my Son William Taylor and my Daughter
Eliza Petersen one pair of cart wheels &c
My will and desire is that all my Estate should be kept
together until Christmas then the residue of my Estate of whatever
kind and wherever found to be sold and after the payment
of my just debts to be equally divided between the above
