

Item - I give and bequeath unto my son Allen Dolez the plantation whereon Willis Dolez now lives and Negro man Peter and Negro girl Tempy one boy Jack one feather bed and furniture to him and his heirs forever

Item - I give and bequeath to my son Willis Dolez the sum of twenty five shillings to him and his heirs forever

Item - I give and bequeath unto my son Jesse Dolez and Negro woman Mimy and her son Click one feather bed & furniture to him and his heirs

Item - I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Sally Lang and negro girl Gilly and her brother Bob to her and her heirs forever

Item - I give unto my Daughter Elizabeth Cammish and negro woman Milly and one Negro boy Dempsey to her and her heirs forever

I leave I give and bequeath to my son Patrick Dolez and certain tracts of Land which I purchased from Benjamin Britt to him and his heirs forever

Item - I further give and bequeath unto my son Allen & Brun Dolez each one good Horse Bridle and Saddle for them to receive when they become of age to them and their heirs forever

Item - I leave to my Loving wife Elizabeth Dolez the plantation whereon I now reside with every other species property which I possess that has not been named after paying my last debts - one negro man Isham Excepted which I wish to be sold and apply'd to the payments of my just Debts, until Patrick becomes of age at which time my will and desire is that an equal division shall take place between my said wife and her Child of all the above said property, the Land Excepted, which property I give and bequeath to them and their heirs forever - The said said Land my will and desire is should be equally divided between my sons Herod and James Dolez which land I give and bequeath to them and their heirs forever

I Do Constitute appoint and particularly request Eley Cammish Willie Sanford and Willie Dolez my whole and sole Executors to this my Last Will and Testament In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & Seal this 12th day of March 1808 -
