 I now live with three negroes named Charles, Peter & Kate & the whole of my person-
 al Estate during her life or widowhood. Item, I give & bequeath to my son Thomas
 Washington the Tract of land and plantation whereon he now lives containing one
 hundred Acres more or less lying on the South side of Ready hoe branch, to
 him & his heirs forever; if in case that my son Thomas dies without lawful heir
 it is my will & desire that my son John Washington shall heir the said Land.
 I give & bequeath to my son Thomas Washington my negro man Daniel. —
 Item, I give & bequeath to my son Ethelred Washington the Tract of Land & plantation
 whereon he now lives, containing one hundred Acres more or less lying on North
 side of Ready hoe branch, to him & his heirs forever, also I give my negro boy Will
 to my son Ethelred Washington and likewise my negro boy Peter after the death
 of my wife. Item, I give & bequeath after the death of my wife the Tract of
 Land & plantation whereon I now live containing one hundred & Twenty Acres
 more or less, to my son John Washington giving my daughter Elizabeth Washington
 a right to live in my dwelling house during her single life, to him & his
