Southampton, being of sound mind and memory thank be to god for the
same, do make and ordain this to be my last will and Testament in
manner and form following: Inprimis: In the first place I desire
that all my just debts should be paid, to effect which, I desire that my
executor hereafter named should sell my tract of land on the three
creeks, that formerly belonged to the Thorps, also my stud horse
and dog - fish mare, with any other species of property that I have
that he may think advisable: Item, I give unto my daughter
in Law Jane Mason my Pheaton and harness to her hers forever.
Item, I give unto my grand-daughter Rebecca Thumath Mason
daughter of Seth Mason, my plow or plow filley, and also leave
my executor to get her a nice Saddle and bridle, I say, I give
it to her & hers forever. Item, I lend unto my brother Richard
