Item, I give and bequeath unto my wife Mary during the term of her natural life or widowhood the following negroes, namely, Jack, Patt, Mingo, Lenny, Aaron, and Davey and Ned, also the remainder of my estate of what nature or kind soever after my last death are paid, and after her death or marriage my will and desire is that the said negroes as well as the residue of my estate be equally divided between my two children Jordan Underwood and Charlotte Porter, And lastly I do constitute and appoint my wife Mary Underwood my coe in Law Thomas Porter and my son Jordan Underwood whole and sole Executors to this my last will and Testament. In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal the day and year first above written.
