In obedience to an order of the County Court of Southampton was Jacob Darden, J^{es}rs. Botte and Richard Dillard having examined stated and settled an acct^s current of the estate of George Williams deceased with Absalom Williams his executor, and finds a balance of £492.14.11¹/₄ due the estate as above stated. It appears however to your commissioners, that by the last Will and Testament of the decedent, this estate is to be equally distributed amongst five of the children of the decedent, to wit Absalom Williams (the son) Elizabeth Darden (the wife of Elisha Darden) Elititia Grantham (wife of James Grantham) Janet Story (the wife of John Story) and Nancy Sandifer. We also find that all those legatees became purchasers at the sale of the estate so to be distributed: the amount of which purchases together with other acct^s which some of them had made with the said Absalom Williams were held by him as p^{ro}p^{er}ties to their several claims as Legatees and to be used in that way on a final settlement of the estate, as the amount of their several portions could not be known before that event happened. We find that the accounts thus made (and as
