

Sixteen feet long and twelve feet wide with a plank floor and in other respects comfortable —

Item - I give to John Henry Persons Westbrooke one bay horse named Jack, one Cow and calf, one Sow and pigs two oxen, two grubbing hoes, and two weeding hoes, one Iron pot, three hundred pounds of pork, and eighteen barrels of corn which said articles are for the use of the plantation which I have before given to the said John Henry Persons Westbrooke —

Item - I give and bequeath to my Brother Thomas Westbrooke four negroes namely, Big Sam, Baker Sam, George and Tom to him and his heirs forever —

Item - I give and bequeath to my Brother Thomas Westbrooke the remainder of the land I bought of Ambrose Andrews after laying out the twenty acres I have given to my yellow woman slave Chabette to him and his heirs forever —

Item - I give and bequeath to my Brother Thomas Westbrooke the land left me by my brother Henry Westbrooke, to him and his heirs forever —

Item - I give and bequeath to my Brother Thomas Westbrooke, all my right title and Interest, in all the estate, both real and personal, which my brother Henry Westbrooke is entitled to, as distributee of the reversionary parts of my father's estate, to my said Brother Thomas and his heirs forever —

Item - I give and bequeath to my Brother Thomas Westbrooke all my right title and Interest in all the estate both real and personal to which I am entitled as distributee of the reversionary parts of my father's estate to my said Brother Thomas and his heirs forever —

Item - I give and bequeath to my Brother Thomas Westbrooke all that part of my mother's estate to which as one of her heirs I am entitled, to him and his heirs forever —

Item - I give and bequeath to Peggy Westbrooke wife of Thomas Westbrooke my silver watch; and to her daughter Harriet Westbrooke, one large gilt looking glass —

Item, I give and bequeath to my Brother Thomas Westbrooke my yoke of oxen and my ox cart and wheels to him and his heirs forever —

Item - I give and bequeath to John Henry Persons Westbrooke, my pair of cart wheels to him and his heirs but the wheels worked by horses —

Item - my will and desire is that after my just debts are paid, that the remainder of my estate not before given away, of what kind soever or wheresoever found, shall be equally divided as follows (to wit) into six equal shares; which I give and bequeath in the following manner viz. to Thomas Westbrooke, one share, to Lucy Bittle one share, to the orphans of Persons Westbrooke one share, to Francis Brister one share, to Rebecca Tillan one share and to Sally Andrews one share —
