I James Irwin of Southampton County do make my last will and testament as follows To wit I give to Mrs Elizabeth Blunt wife of Doct Samuel Blunt my bay horse Silver; Item I give to Doct Samuel Blunt my gold watch. Item I desire that one hundred Dollars shall be raised out of my estate and kept in trust by Samuel Blunt, and by him to be given to Molly Macniel at such times and in such manner as he in his discretion shall think proper, untill the principals and interest of the said one hundred shall be exhausted. Item I desire that my lot in the Town of Bellfield in the County of Greenville, and also my lots in the Town of Jerusalem in the County of Southampton, and also all other property which I possess of every kind whatsoever, not before given away may be sold by my executor hereafter to be appointed, in such manner, and on such credit as he may think most beneficial to my estate and concerns, and from the proceeds of the sale of the said property, I desire that in the first place my just debts may be paid; then what may remain I give to my Father Arthur Irwin, of the Isles in the County of Meath near Kells in the Kingdom of Ireland, in case he should be alive, and if he should be dead, I give what may remain as aforesaid equally between my Two Brothers George Irwin and James Irwin - Lastly I do nominate and appoint Samuel Blunt executor to this my last will and Testament, and desire that he may in the execution of my will, act according to his discretion, as regards the sale of my estate before directed: In Testimony of this my will and Testament I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this Twenty second day of May in the year one Thousand eight hundred and nine.
