Rights in and to the thing parts thereof to him and his heirs
forever - I furthermore give him the following, Slaves (twelve),
Ellis, Squires & Eliza, with her Increase, also one Black walnut
Chest, and one Black walnut Table which I have lent to my wife
but after her death or widowhood to my son Willis, and whatever
property I have heretofore possessed him with to him and
his heirs forever -

I the said to my Daughter Lucy Williamson, the following Slaves
during her natural life (to wit), Gilly, Laura, Bob, and Wmmy,
with their Increase also twenty seven pounds Cash, one feather
bedstead and furniture, one Black walnut chest of drawers
and five head of cattle (second Choice) and at the death of
my said Daughter Lucy, if she should leave any living child
or children in that case I wish the aforesaid property lent to be
equally divided among them or to one child, if there should be
no more, which I give to the one child if more to them, or to
and its heirs or their heirs forever - as the case may be & if
no heir born of her body as aforesaid. I wish in that case at
the death of my daughter Lucy, that this Slaves and other property
lent her during her natural life be sold and the money arising
from such sales be equally divided among my other children
to them and their heirs forever -

I the said to my nephew John Williamson six Shillings lent to
him and his heirs forever -

I furthermore will that all my estate after my just debts are
paid, that is not heretofore given away and lent should be sold
to the highest bidder & the amount thereof to be equally divided
among my six children in manner and form following (to wit)
To my son David Williamson one sixth part to him and his heirs forever
To my son Joseph Williamson one sixth part to him & his heirs forever
To my daughter Silvia Andrews, I lend one sixth part during her
life and after her death I give it to her heirs lawfully begotten of
her body to them and their heirs forever -
To my daughter Marianna Stephenson I lend one sixth part during
her natural life and after her death I give it to her heirs lawfully
begotten of her body to them & their heirs forever -
To my son William Williamson one sixth part to him and his
heirs forever -

To my daughter Lucy Williamson one sixth part to her
and her heirs forever -
