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or either of them for the same; but in case she or any person whom she may marry; or otherwise place in trust of her business shall be found in the neglect of this duty; I then desire that my estate should be divided giving to her the same interest in it which she would have been entitled to if I had died intestate, and the balance to be equally divided between my two children Mariah H. Greey and Ephraim Greey to them their heirs and assigns forever.

Item - Should my wife keep the property together agreeable to the second clause or item of this will, during her life I then at her death give the whole estate, or such of it as may be then remaining, both land, slaves and other property to be equally divided between my two children above named to them their heirs and assigns forever.

Lastly I hereby nominate and appoint my friends Jacob Dargen and Saml Dargen to be the executors of this my last will and Testament ratifying and confirming, thus and no other to be my true last will and Testament - In Witness whereof I the said Ephraim Greey have hereunto set my hand and seal this seventh day of August 1809 -
