In the name of God Amen I Thomas Washington of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia being weak in body tho' of perfect understanding and memory thanks be to God, calling to mind the mortality of my body and knowing it is appointed for all men once to die, do make and ordain this my last will and Testament. Viz^t principally and first of all I give and recommend my soul into the hands of Almighty God who gave it, and my body I recommend to the earth to be buried in a decent Christian burial at the discretion of my dear wife & executors & as touching such worldly estates as it hath pleased God to bless me with, I give devise and dispose of in the following manner and form (to wit) I leave to my loving wife Peggy Washington the use of my land and plantation whereon I now live during her life in widowhood; after her death or marriage to be equally divided between my son George Washington and the child my wife Peggy Washington is now pregnant with also I give to my wife Peggy Washington my female man, and my negro man by the name of Ned, and six head of cattle of her own choice and two sows and pigs and eight hogs, & fifteen barrels of corn and eight hundred weight of pork & also two
