In the name of God Amen

I Albrigton Jones of Southampton Virginia being in a low state of health but of perfect mind and memory do make and deliver the following writing to be my last will and Testament To wit, I give devise and bequeath unto my loving wife Mary Jones the use of the lands and plantation whereon I now live and all the issues and profits thereof during the minority of my son Thomas C. Jones, or her widowhood and after my said son Thomas C. Jones shall arrive to the age of twenty one years my will is that my said wife have the use and profits of one third part of my manor plantation & lands only during her natural life or widowhood, which said third part is to be laid off and set apart by Commissioners whom the County Court of Southampton may deem proper to appoint for that purpose. That my said son Thomas C. Jones hold and enjoy the remaining two thirds of my said Manor plantation and lands from and after his arrival to the age aforesaid and receive and enjoy all the profits thereof till the death or marriage of my said wife and after the death or marriage aforesaid of my said wife I give and devise all my said manor plantation and lands unto my said son Thomas C. Jones. Contained in the following boundaries namely. Lying on the north and south of the road leading from black water bridges to South Lee. Bounding northwesterly by the lands of Albrigton Harries and Griffin. Thence to the road leading from Jerusalem to Southway thence down said road to the lands which I sold to Mills Surfer thence down said Surfer's line to the lands of William Edwards thence down said William Edwards's line to the line of John Williams thence on said Williams line to the line of John Edwards thence from the line of said Edwards along the old line which used to divide my said tract from that formerly belonging to James Knight thence to said Albrigton Harries lands the beginning
