age of Eighteen years to him and his heirs forever —

Item

I give and bequeath unto my Grandson Thomas Barrow, one
Negro Man Byrd, one Negro woman, Chinna, and one hundred
pounds cash, to him & his heirs forever, to be continued in the
hands of the executors untill he arrives to the age of Eighteen
years — also one feather bed & furniture —

Item

I lend unto my son Henry Barrow the remainders of my estate
of what nature or kind soever, during his life, and after his
Death I desire the said legacy to be equally divided among his
Children legally begotten to them & their heirs forever —

And Lastly I do hereby appoint my son Henry Barrow and
Ethelred Edmunds executors to this my last will and Testament.
