Two pewter dishes, Six pewter plates one pewter Bason, one 3 gallon Jug, one narrow and one broad axe, one Case of Bottles, one Chest one bread Tray & Sifter, one Corbel mare one earthen Dish, one large earthen pot, one Coopers adze
I give & bequeath to my Son Joseph Branch half my Cider Barrells, all my Coopers Tools except an adze above mentioned one Still pitcher one Gun, one Coopers Still Cap. & worm. after paying to my Son Goodman Branch, the Sum of Eight pounds

I Give and bequeath to my Son in law Amos Washington, one Cross Cut Saw, 1 Case of bottles which he has now in possession, half of my Cider Barrells, and one pair Steelyards

I give and bequeath, the remainder of my Estate of all kinds whatsoever to my daughter Sally Branch
