In the name of God Amen I Peggy Duwell of the County of Southampton being of perfect mind and memory and knowing that it is appointed for all once to die do make & ordain this my last will and Testament in manner & form following that is to say.

First

I give and bequeath to my Cousin Elizabeth Jordan daughter of Rebecca Jordan that tract or parcel of land lying in the County of Sussex which descended to me from my Grand father William Jordan, provided she has lawful issue, but it is my will and desire that in case she should die without lawful issue as aforesaid then and in that case I give and devise the said tract or parcel of land unto my several uncles and aunts to be equally divided amongst them, to them and their heirs forever —

2nd

I give all my wearing apparel & all other of my estate of what nature or kind soever to Elizabeth Salsby, and Mary Ellis Children of Michael Ellis to them and their heirs forever and I do nominate and appoint my friend Michael Ellis my sole & sole executor of this my last will & Testament. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 23rd day of December 1809.
