Joseph Draper's
Will

Calling to mind that it is appointed for all men once to die & Joseph Draper of the County of Southampton being in sound mind and memory and do think fit to constitute and ordain this my last will and testament in manner and form following viz

Item

I give and bequeath unto my son Joseph Draper the land and plantation whereon I now live all to the use to him and his heirs forever

Item

I give and bequeath unto my youngest son Silas Draper all the remainder of my lands bounded by my fathers will by estimation thirty five acres be the same more or less unto him and his heirs forever. Also ten pounds in cash to my son Silas Draper to him and his heirs forever. Also one feather bed and furniture. Also one cow and calf to him and his heirs forever -

Item

I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Patience Draper one feather bed and furniture one small pewter Dish to her and her heirs forever

Item

I give and bequeath unto my loving wife Priscilla Draper one riding mare only for my eldest son Eley Draper to have the use of her till he can raise one from her not depriving my wife from the use of her. Also one feather bed and furniture one wearing bonnet and gear belonging therunto during her natural life -

Item

I give and bequeath all the remainder of my estate to be equally divided between my loving wife Priscilla Draper and my three children Patience Draper & Joseph Draper and Silas Draper to them and their heirs forever and at the death of my wife for the whole to be equally divided between my four children Patience, Eley, Joseph and Silas Draper to them and their heirs forever -

I also Denominate and appoint my loving wife Priscilla Draper and my Eldest son Eley Draper my whole and sole executor of this my last will and Testament here to made by me as

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
